

# SMOKE DETECTOR REQUEST FORM

Each year, approximately 1,000 children under the age of 15 – die in a home fire; that’s an average of three children per day. In many instances, those deaths could have been prevented if the home had been equipped with a properly installed and working smoke detector.

As part of the Romulus Fire Department’s Fire Prevention and Education Program, we will be offering a limited number of free smoke detectors to eligible homeowners.
